IPFCA will customize a CISM program you, each occupation, Department, or company.

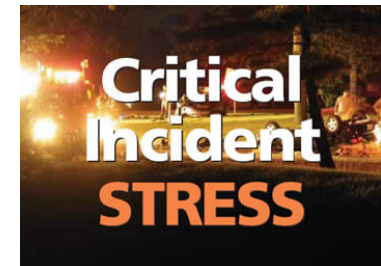

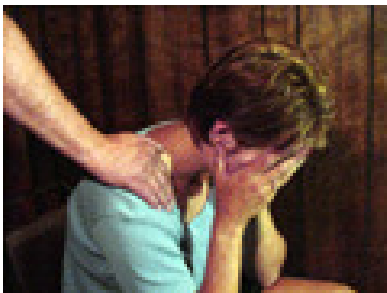
